## **GILLS ROAD, SOUTH DARENTH**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that Gills Road, South Darenth will be closed to through traffic, on or after 17th May 2023 for up to 1 day.**

**The road will be closed between The Lodge & Orchard View.**

**The alternative route is via Green Street Green Road, Sandbanks Hill, St Margarets Road, Gills Road.**

**This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.**
